EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

Customers will be required to have:

- 1) Bill of Sale
- 2) Title (if applicable)
- 3) Verification of Prior Registration (current or expired registration)

Effective July 1, 2007 – a legislative change made it possible to conduct a "transfer of ownership" of a Snowmobile / ATV or Boat while the registration is expired. The purpose of the legislative change to allow transferring of ownership on expired registration was to simplify the process of transferring ownership.

BOATS: Effective July 1, 2005 – Casual sales of watercraft vessels are no longer exempt from sales tax per the lowa Department of Revenue.

7% Sales Tax will be collected on the purchase price of the watercraft within state.

6% Sales Tax will be collected for out of state purchases.

SNOWMOBILES/ATV/ORV'S: Effective July 1, 2009 – Casual sales on these machines are no longer exempt from sales tax due to a change in lowa Code.

7% Sale Tax will be collected on the purchase price for in state purchases.

6% Sale Tax will be collected for out of state purchases.
