Refusal to Sign Authorization

My revocation will not affect actions taken by this medical practice prior to its receipt. I understand that, if the recipient of the information is not a health care provider or health plan covered by HIPAA, the information used or disclosed as described above may be redisclosed by the recipient and no longer protected by HIPAA. However, other State or Federal laws may prohibit the recipient from disclosing specially protected information, such as abuse treatment information, HIV/AIDS-related information, and psychiatric/mental health information.
